Day 02 Sat 25 Aug: Arrive Rome - Civitavecchia – Embarkation

Upon arrival at Rome Air port, transfer to the port of Civitavecchia to embark the ship **Mariner of the Seas**. Depart 7pm.

Day 03 Sun 26 Aug: Arrive Genoa

Arrive Genoa at 7am, depart 7pm.

Day 04 Mon 27 Aug: Ajaccio, Corsica

Arrive Ajaccio 7am, depart 4pm.

Day 05 Tue 28 Aug: Barcelona

Arrive 9am, depart 8pm.

Day 06 Wed 29 Aug: Palma de Mallorca

Arrive 7am, depart 3pm.

Day 07 Thu 30 Aug: Tunis

Arrive 2pm, depart 8pm.

Day 08 Fri 31 Aug: Cruising

Day 09 Sat 01 Sep: Arrive Civitavecchia - San Marino

We disembark around 8am to board our coach that will take us to San Marino. (D)

Day 10 Sun 02 Sep – Am San Marino – PM to Venice

Morning at leisure in San Marino. Afternoon we follow the "Strada Romea" to Ravenna. Comacchio and on to Venice. (B, D)

We begin the day with our morning included tour of St. Mark' Square with local guide and visit to a glass factory. Afternoon free In Venice, return to the hotel in the late evening for dinner. (B, D)

In the afternoon we drive to Verona to see the famous Arena and the balcony that inspired Shakespeare to write Romeo and Juliet. After optional lunch, we continue to our hotel in Lake Garda. (B, D) Hotel

Day 13 Wed 5 Sep: Lake Garda

Full day at leisure on the lake. Why not take an optional boat trip of the lake or mingle amongst the locals.

Day 14 Thu 06 Sep: Lake Garda to Florence - Afternoon in Florence

After breakfast, we drive to Florence for our included tour of Florence with local guide. (B, D)

Day 16 Sat 08 Sep: Sorrento

Today, you will see the jewels of the Amalfitan Coast: Positano, Amalfi and Ravello. (B, D)

Day 17 Sun 09 Sep: Sorrento – Pompei - Rome

Stop at Pompei for included tour with local guide (entrance fees included). After we proceed to Rome. (B, D)

Day 18 Mon 10 Sep: Rome

Morning Sistine Chapel (entrance fees included). Afternoon City tour with local guide. (B, D)

Day 19 Tue 11 Sep: Rome - return flight to Australia

Transfer to Rome airport for your return flight to Australia.

Day 20 Wed 12 Sep: Arrive Australia
