Our fleet of 179 passenger aircrafts now operate more than 5,400 flights a week to 98 destinations around the world. We want to be the airline of choice for Italians and for anyone planning to fly to Italy or stop there on their way to any other destination around the world.

We are currently extending our network in order to consolidate our position as a leading carrier in the world's fast-growing areas. These include the Mediterranean, the Middle East and Eastern Europe.
